Instruction for Payment GIS Workshop on Manipulating Ambulance Data

In connection to the captioned GIS workshop, participants are required to make **full payment of HK\$6,000** as the workshop fee to the Department of Geography in accordance with the payment instructions below. The participants need to confirm their payment with the Department **by Wednesday 17 May 2017.**

Payment Instructions

1. You shall make **the full payment by cash at the HSBC counter** into the following **HKU bank account no. 002-222834-001** (Make sure to provide this right account no. to the counter staff because HKU has different HSBC accounts for different purposes.) **Make sure that you ask for the Customer Copy of the Payment Slip as a record of your payment.**
2. Alternatively, you can use the HSBC ATM machine or online banking to make direct payment transfer to the above-mentioned HKU bank account. After you have completed the transaction, **make sure to obtain a printed copy of the ATM payment receipt or print a copy of the online transaction record – this is the only documentary proof to show that you have paid.**
3. On the front of the HSBC Payment Slip / ATM receipt / Online Transaction Record, please make sure to write down the following information:
 - (a) Your Full Name, and (b) the remark ‘GIS Workshop on Ambulance Data’.
4. You **shall send a clear copy of the Customer Copy/ATM receipt / Online Transaction Record (with the above-requested information) to Dr C.T. LOW by email (chientat@hku.hk) no later than Wednesday 17 May 2017** so as to confirm that you have made the payment. The Department will issue an official receipt to you in due course.
