**About the Speaker**

Prof Wallin is also affiliated with the Council of Logistics Management, American Society of Transportation and Logistics, and Delta Nu Alpha. He has assisted in the development of the Graduate Diploma in Transport and Logistics at HKUST and has lectured in the program as well as, regularly, in IEEM Courses in Transportation, Logistics, and Technology Marketing.

**Seminar Abstract**

In the seminar, Prof Wallin will discuss the strategies which can be used in delineating areas of research interest. He will review the structuring of the research process, the types of research materials and approaches available, and the definition of contribution to be made by a dissertation in a taught Master degree programme. He will spend time with students individually, should they want to discuss specific research areas or streams.
